ΕΙΣΑΓΩΓΗ

αποστολή

Η μη Κυβερνητική Οργάνωση ΕΛΙΞ καλλιεργεί, από το 1987, την εθελοντική συνείδηση και προωθεί την εθελοντική προσφορά. Βασικός στόχος της είναι η συμβολή στην προσωπική ανάπτυξη του ατόμου και η εξέλιξή του ως πολίτη του κόσμου μέσα από την ενεργό συμμετοχή στα κοινά. Η ΕΛΙΞ πραγματοποιεί διεθνείς δράσεις εθελοντικής συμμετοχής με αντικείμενο την προστασία του περιβάλλοντος, τη διατήρηση της πολιτιστικής κληρονομιάς, την προώθηση του πολιτισμού και την κοινωνική προσφορά.

στόχος

Στόχος της ΕΛΙΞ είναι να συγκροτεί ομάδες ανθρώπων από όλο τον κόσμο, με διαφορετικές καταβολές, οι οποίοι, μέσα από τη συμμετοχή τους σε προγράμματα εθελοντικής εργασίας περιβαλλοντικού, πολιτιστικού, κοινωνικού ενδιαφέροντος, ζουν, μαθαίνουν και εργάζονται ομαδικά. Τα προγράμματα εθελοντικής εργασίας της ΕΛΙΞ προωθούν τη διαπολιτισμική ανταλλαγή μεταξύ των εθελοντών και τους προσφέρουν τη δυνατότητα να συμμετέχουν ενεργά στην καθημερινή ζωή μιας τοπικής κοινωνίας.

δράσεις

🌀 Η ΕΛΙΞ οργανώνει προγράμματα εθελοντικής εργασίας δύο ή τριών εβδομάδων, κυρίως κατά τη διάρκεια του καλοκαιριού, όπου οι συμμετέχοντες μαθαίνουν, μεταξύ άλλων, παραδοσιακές τεχνικές συντήρησης και αναπαλαίωσης πέτρινων κτηρίων, καθαρισμό και διάνοιξη μονοπατιών και καλντεριμιών. Κατά τη διάρκεια ενός προγράμματος εθελοντικής εργασίας, οι εθελοντές προσφέρουν εθελοντική εργασία σε διάφορους φορείς φιλοξενίας, οργανώνουν και συμμετέχουν σε διάφορες πολιτιστικές και άλλες δράσεις, μοιράζονται ιδέες. Τα προγράμματα της ΕΛΙΞ προσφέρουν στους κατοίκους μικρών και μεγάλων κοινοτήτων της Ελλάδας την ευκαιρία να έρθουν σε επαφή με ανθρώπους από όλο τον κόσμο και, με τη συμβολή αυτών, να πραγματοποιήσουν σημαντικές δράσεις.

🌀 Η ΕΛΙΞ διοργανώνει εκπαιδευτικά σεμινάρια για ομαδάρχες προγραμμάτων εθελοντικής εργασίας. Επίσης, πολλές δράσεις που απευθύνονται σε εθελοντές, καθ' όλη τη διάρκεια του χρόνου, όπως για παράδειγμα μονοήμερες ή διήμερες εκδρομές, περιβαλλοντικές, πολιτιστικές και άλλες δράσεις, τακτικές συναντήσεις με τους εθελοντές.

🌀 Τέλος, η ΕΛΙΞ πραγματοποιεί δύο προγράμματα φιλοξενίας μέσα στα πλαίσια της Ευρωπαϊκής Εθελοντικής Υπηρεσίας του Προγράμματος "Νέα Γενιά σε δράση", μέσω του οποίου, κάθε χρόνο, στέλνει επίσης ένα μεγάλο αριθμό εθελοντών στο εξωτερικό.

πόροι

Οι πόροι της ΕΛΙΞ προέρχονται κυρίως από τα ποσά που πληρώνουν οι εθελοντές για συμμετοχή σε πρόγραμμα εθελοντικής εργασίας, τοπικούς και εθνικούς φορείς, όπως η Γενική Γραμματεία Νέας Γενιάς, το Υπουργείο Περιβάλλοντος, Χωροταξίας & Δημοσίων Έργων, το Υπουργείο Απασχόλησης και Κοινωνικής Προστασίας, από Ιδρύματα και ιδιωτικούς φορείς, από δωρεές και από Ευρωπαϊκά προγράμματα, όπως το Leonardo da Vinci κα.

ΓΕΝΙΚΕΣ ΠΛΗΡΟΦΟΡΙΕΣ

Τα προγράμματα εθελοντικής εργασίας στην Ελλάδα διοργανώνονται σε συνεργασία με υπουργεία, οργανισμούς τοπικής αυτοδιοίκησης, δασικές υπηρεσίες, πολιτιστικούς συλλόγους, κλπ. Η διάρκειά τους ποικίλλει, από 2 έως 3 εβδομάδες, και πραγματοποιούνται κυρίως κατά τους καλοκαιρινούς μήνες. Οι περισσότερες ομάδες αποτελούνται από 15 εθελοντές και δύο ομαδάρχες που είναι επικεφαλής της ομάδας. Η ΕΛΙΞ καθορίζει για κάθε πρόγραμμα ένα συντονιστή, ο οποίος βρίσκεται σε συνεχή επικοινωνία με τους ομαδάρχες και το φορέα φιλοξενίας. Τα προγράμματα κατά την πλειοψηφία τους απευθύνονται σε ενήλικους εθελοντές, εκτός από την περίπτωση των προγραμμάτων ειδικά για εφήβους. Εφόσον ανήλικοι εθελοντές επιθυμούν να συμμετάσχουν σε ένα από τα προγράμματα της ΕΛΙΞ, πρέπει να συνοδεύουν την αίτησή τους με μία επιστολή συναίνεσης για τη συμμετοχή τους, υπογεγραμμένη από γονείς ή κηδεμόνες.

εργασία

Κάθε φορέας φιλοξενίας καθορίζει, σε συνεργασία με την ΕΛΙΞ την εργασία που θα παράσχει η ομάδα και υποχρεούται να καθοδηγεί την ομάδα κατά τη διάρκεια του προγράμματος, καθώς και να ενημερώνει την οργάνωση για οποιαδήποτε αλλαγή, ώστε να ενημερώνονται, με τη σειρά τους και οι εθελοντές. Καθώς υπάρχουν αστάθμητοι παράγοντες, ίσως κάποιες φορές να μην είναι δυνατή η ενημέρωση των εθελοντών για αλλαγές στη δουλειά, πριν την έναρξη του προγράμματος. Πάντα, παρόλα αυτά, η ΕΛΙΞ φροντίζει να ενημερώνει έγκαιρα και σωστά όλους τους συμμετέχοντες. Οι εθελοντές εργάζονται 5-6 ώρες την ημέρα, 5 μέρες την εβδομάδα, με την καθοδήγηση ενός τεχνίτη του φορέα φιλοξενίας, αν αυτό κριθεί απαραίτητο από τη φύση της εργασίας. Οι εθελοντές πρέπει να έχουν υπεύθυνη στάση σε σχέση με την εργασία του προγράμματος που έχουν επιλέξει. Κατά συνέπεια, να φέρονται με σύνεση και να έχουν κατανόηση.

διαμονή

Η ΕΛΙΞ, σε συνεργασία με τους φορείς φιλοξενίας, διαμορφώνει χώρους κατάλληλους για τη διαμονή των εθελοντών. Οι εθελοντές, συνήθως, φιλοξενούνται σε σχολεία, κέντρα νέων, ξενώνες, κλπ., με βασικές ευκολίες (ντους, τουαλέτες). Κάθε μέρα, σύμφωνα με πρόγραμμα που καταρτίζεται από τους ομαδάρχες και σε συνεργασία με την ομάδα, δύο εθελοντές είναι υπεύθυνοι για την καθαριότητα του χώρου φιλοξενίας της ομάδας, καθώς και την προετοιμασία όλων των γευμάτων της ημέρας.

γλώσσα

Τα προγράμματα της ΕΛΙΞ έχουν, στην πλειοψηφία τους, ως γλώσσα επικοινωνίας την αγγλική. Υπάρχουν και περιπτώσεις γαλλόφωνων ή ελληνόφωνων προγραμμάτων. Σε κάθε περίπτωση, οι εθελοντές πρέπει να μπορούν να επικοινωνούν με τα υπόλοιπα μέλη της ομάδας τους και με τους ομαδάρχες.

ασφάλιση

Οι εθελοντές ασφαλιζονται από την ΕΛΙΞ, σε περίπτωση ατυχήματος, για όλη τη διάρκεια του προγράμματος στο οποίο συμμετέχουν. Πρώτες βοήθειες παρέχονται άμεσα.

ελεύθερος χρόνος

Οι δραστηριότητες του ελεύθερου χρόνου στα περισσότερα προγράμματα δεν είναι δυνατόν να καθοριστούν εκ των προτέρων. Εξαρτώνται από τις δυνατότητες που προσφέρονται σε κάθε περιοχή, καθώς και από τα ενδιαφέροντα και τις ανάγκες της ομάδας. Οι δραστηριότητες του ελεύθερου χρόνου δεν καλύπτονται οικονομικά από την ΕΛΙΞ.

έξοδα

Η ΕΛΙΞ σε συνεργασία με κάθε φορέα φιλοξενίας καλύπτει τη διαμονή και τη διατροφή των εθελοντών, αλλά οι εθελοντές πρέπει να καλύψουν τις ταξιδιωτικές τους δαπάνες, καθώς και τις δαπάνες για τον ελεύθερο χρόνο, κατά τη διάρκεια του προγράμματος.

ποσό συμμετοχής

Το ποσό συμμετοχής σε ένα πρόγραμμα εθελοντικής εργασίας είναι €100. Για κάθε επιπλέον πρόγραμμα, η συμμετοχή ανέρχεται στα €80. Οι εθελοντές πληρώνουν το ποσό συμμετοχής είτε μέσω τραπεζικής μεταφοράς με ονομαστική κατάθεση είτε στα γραφεία της οργάνωσης με μετρητά. Σε κάποια προγράμματα πιθανό είναι να υπάρχει ένα extra fee – κυρίως σε αναπτυσσόμενες χώρες – που πληρώνεται κατευθείαν στους ομαδάρχες, όταν φτάνουν στο πρόγραμμα.

επεξήγηση για τους τίτλους των προγραμμάτων :

Οι χαρακτηριστές στην αρχή του τίτλου αποτελούν τη συντομογραφία της οργάνωσης φιλοξενίας, ακολουθεί ο αριθμός του προγράμματος και το όνομά του. Στη συνέχεια, αναγράφονται η περιοχή ή η ευρύτερη περιοχή που διεξάγεται το πρόγραμμα, οι ημερομηνίες ή η διάρκειά του, το είδος του προγράμματος και τέλος ο αριθμός των συμμετεχόντων εθελοντών και το όριο ηλικίας. Θα πρέπει να σημειώσουμε ότι μερικές οργανώσεις δεν ακολουθούν αυτή τη μορφοποίηση στους τίτλους τους αλλά σε γενικές γραμμές όλες έχουν την ίδια διάταξη.

σημείωση :

Για τα προγράμματα εθελοντικής εργασίας που ακολουθούν , έχει γίνει **κράτηση 1 ή 2 θέσεων** για έλληνες εθελοντές , **μέχρι τις 30 Μαΐου**. Σε περίπτωση που δεν καλυφθούν από έλληνες εθελοντές οι θέσεις θα ανοίξουν για εθελοντές από τις υπόλοιπες χώρες. PREPARATION DAYS (Obligatory and free)!

Location: Marche-en-Famenne

Dates: From Friday 9th to Saturday 10th of July **Purpose:** To gather all the volunteers and camp leaders who participate in projects that start on the same date. This is also the official welcome session offered by the CBB team. On Saturday, all the volunteers will leave for their own workcamp place. **The project:** "Centre Couleurs du Monde" is a refugee centre of the Belgian Red Cross that takes care of refugees. At a time it can host up to 165 people who asked for asylum in Belgium. Their stay in the centre is temporary and lasts until the necessary documents to stay legally in this country are ready and their refugee status is proved. Centre provides such services as accommodation, food, educational courses, medical and social help, cultural, sport events etc. One of the most important point is that the centre can grant for inhabitants is international exchange not only between themselves but also between them and volunteers from all over the world. That is the main purpose of the camp – intercultural exchange by way of work. But don't be lazy and explore the internet by yourself – you can find a lot of information ☺. **Work:** If you are creative, if you like to decorate using all sources of your imagination – that's your camp! Freedom for your ideas! And the center's corridor waits for you – it needs to be decorated to create a warm atmosphere and give a chance to work together – volunteers and refugees. Feel free to bring any thoughts and suggestions. Are you good at photographing, cannot live without painting, or love to work with textile? Wood, glass, paper? Or you have your own technology of decoration? You are very welcome! If you are going to use some specific 'tools' that the Centre probably cannot have such as camera – take them with you, except surely ladders, brushes, paint etc ☺. **Accommodation:** Accommodation will be provided in the Centre itself – 2 rooms per 4 volunteers each. Every room has its own bathroom and toilet. Smoking and alcohol drinking inside is strictly forbidden. **Food:** Food will be provided, relax – no cooking! But if volunteers want to prepare something special to their new friends – it is really welcome! Good news if you do not like pork – due to some of the refugees do not eat that, it is not cooked. If you keep a vegetarian diet – you are welcome as well. **Location:** Rendeux is a countryside village that lies in the country's Walloon Region and Luxembourg Province and accounts up to 2,500 inhabitants. The village of Rendeux is situated in the valley of the River Ourthe in an area which attracts many visitors both for its natural beauty and for such nearby medieval villages as La Roche and Durbuy. For more details, please, visit: www.rendeux.be **Specific information:** Motivation letter is necessary. **Meeting Point:** Marche-en-Famenne train station, on Friday 9th July between 4.30 and 5.30 pm. Volunteers will go to Rendeux together on Saturday. **Camp language:** English and French, and also due to a lot of people all over the world are here, you can discover numerous of others! Facial expression, sign language and emotional interjections may help you in any situation! Feel free!

PREPARATION DAYS (Obligatory and free)!

Location: Marche-en-Famenne **Dates:** From Friday 6th to 7th Saturday from of August **Purpose:** To gather all the volunteers and camp leaders who participate in projects that start on the same date. This is also the official welcome session offered by the CBB team. On Saturday, all the volunteers will leave for their own workcamp place. **The project:** The Marche-en-Famenne workcamp is the outcome of the collaboration between municipal authorities and a local non-profit organisation. Six years ago, the mayor and deputies wanted to develop international contacts for the local youngsters. GRIMM association was just beginning to work on the protection of the local life framework and promoting models of sustainable development. Their members had a full load of ideas but were short of hands to realise them. Thus, they came to the idea of involving volunteers from all over the world. Since then, the municipality provides its buildings every summer and welcomes foreign youngsters. GRIMM members organise the work.

With the help from the volunteers, they are finally able to realise the projects they dreamt about. Their actions are based on the following philosophy: Nature belongs to everyone. And that each of us may enjoy it, it has to be protected. **Work:** Volunteers will do the construction of two shelters and take care of objects constructed by previous workcamps – a barbecue area, benches, shelter. This workcamp is only based on manual and outdoor tasks and the work might sometimes be exhausting. On the other hand, GRIMM team will prepare a good barbecue for the volunteers to encourage them. **Accommodation:** Accommodation can be compared to a boarding school: a corridor with double bedrooms; toilets and showers are at the same floor. No smoking inside. **Food:** Self-catering. Bring your recipes to enjoy 'kitchen life!' **Location:** Marche-en-Famenne is a city in the countryside. One can find everything there: schools, supermarkets, industries... But still, it is surrounded by woods, fields and small villages where the life rhythm remains rural. Liège, Namur, Brussels and Luxembourg can be easily reached by train in about one hour. For more information see: <http://www.marche-tourisme.be> **Specific information:** During the day, from 7 am to 5 pm, volunteers will cohabit with a group of children using the same refectory. Volunteers will therefore be required not to smoke or drink alcohol in front of the kids. Next, the working place is not the same as the accommodation place so volunteers will leave the town everyday. Sleeping in town, working in the countryside. Please, bring some working clothes and boots you do not mind to get dirty. And rainy clothes in case of wet weather can also be useful. **Meeting point:** Marche-en-Famenne train station, on Friday 6th of August between 4.30 and 5.30 pm. **Camp language:** English and French

Partner The village of Seix is very close to the Pyrenees mountains. Seix has a lot of historical buildings. In the past, the municipality already hosted volunteers. The presence of young volunteers had been appreciated and that is the reason why the municipality wants to start this experience again this year. Despite its small size (820 inhabitants), the village of Seix is a dynamic center in the region. This workcamp will be great for people who are fond of nature and mountains. **Work** You will make work of renovation of a traditional washing place in the village. You will work between 4 and 5 hours a day, 5 days a week. If you have quite a bit of time, you will work on another typical washing place in the hamlet of Aunac, about 3km from the city. You will have to walk more to go to work, between 30 and 45 walking time. You may have working in shifts. **Accommodation And Food** In the municipal school with kitchen and sanitary facilities available. We cannot accommodate you if you arrive before the starting date of the workcamp. Alt-10 Pereyaslav-Khmelnyskyy I Kyiv Region 01/08-14/08 RENO 12 vols 18+ ☺

Project partner: Pereyaslav-Khmelnyskyy Social Services Centre for Youth.

Project: The camp is situated in the suburban part of Pereyaslav-Khmelnyskyy. This town has rich history and a lot of places to see. It is situated on the banks of one of the most beautiful rivers in Ukraine - the Dnieper, 100 km to the south-east of Kyiv – the capital of Ukraine. Pereyaslav-Khmelnyskyy is one of the most important places in Ukrainian history. Pereyaslav-Khmelnyskyy has existed since the 10th century. It was a border stronghold of the Kievan Rus state but was overrun by Tatars in 1239. The town began to recover in the 16th century and emerged as a site of Ukrainian Cossack culture. In 1654, Bohdan Khmelnytskyy and his Cossacks met at Pereyaslav to agree that Ukraine, for protection against Poland, becomes a protectorate of Russia – breakdown in the Ukrainian history. There are 17 museums and 7 magnificent parks in the city, so volunteers will enjoy this place. Well-known in Ukraine - Open-air Museum of Folk Architecture is situated in Pereyaslav. Here you can see, among other things, authentic peasant huts of the times of old, smithies and several windmills of the eighteenth century. In fact, a village of the 17th–19th centuries is recreated, complete with gardens and flowers around the houses with whitewashed walls and thatch roofs. In the houses you find icons and decorative towels – exactly the way it looked in the times of old. On the territory of the open-air museum, you can find other museums, one of which exhibits stone idols of the Scythian times of centuries before Christ. **Work:** Open-air Museum of Folk Architecture is integral part of national Ukrainian heritage and is protected by special law. We continue the 14 year project, repairing the historical objects and cultural monuments, participating in the work on the territory of the historic and cultural recreation area in Pereyaslav-Khmelnyskyy. Volunteers will help the workers of the Museum of Ukrainian Folk Architecture through different activities to restore the museum exhibits and to clean the territory of the museum. **Accommodation:** will be specified in later. The city has a rich history and more than 600 historical, architectural and cultural sights testify to it. It was subscribed in the list of 100 cities of the world with high cultural and historical profile by UNESCO. Bor is a little town 19 km from Nizhniy Novgorod. It is known as a place for spending summer holidays. However, many people live there the whole year. It is located on the bank of the Volga river. The horse club "Polevitsa" is a part of an orthodox community. They have their own farm where they grow vegetables and fruits and keep cows, pigs and rabbits. There are nine horses in the farm, every weekend many people go to ride horse there. Sometimes groups of children from the Nizhniy Novgorod orphanages go there to ride horse too. It is a great opportunity for them to spend time with horses and to get experience and impressions that they cannot get in everyday life. **Work:** The volunteers are expected to help in the rearrangement of a pond near the farm. Furthermore, participants will look after the horses, help with cleaning, feeding and taking care of them. They will also help to look after the other animals of the farm. They will be involved in organizing animation activities for groups of children from orphanages who will come to the "Polevitsa" during the workcamp as well. For three days during the workcamp they will live in the Makariev convent and help in the garden and farm. **Location:** Nizhny Novgorod region, Bor district.
